NOTIFICATION

This Department has notified 5 vacancies in the post of Station Officer vide Notification No.1953-S/FSD/Estt./F.1/2022/STO, dated 04.11.2022. Consequent to the issue of G. O. Ms. No.26, dated 20.06.2023 of the Home Department, Puducherry, it has now been decided to fill up the said vacancies with horizontal reservation of 33% for women. Accordingly, applications are invited from eligible male/female Indian Citizens who are natives/residents of the Union Territory of Puducherry for Direct Recruitment to the post of **Station Officer** (Group-C, Non-Gazetted, Non-Ministerial) in the Fire Service Department, Puducherry as detailed below:-


Abbreviations:

UR - Unreserved, MBC - Most Backward Classes, EWS - Economically Weaker Section, XSM - Ex-Servicemen.

Note:

The Government reserves the right either to enhance or to reduce the number of vacancies notified depending upon the actual requirement at the time of selection and also to cancel the recruitment process. No interim inquiry will be entertained.

As there is no reservation for EWS category for female candidates in this recruitment, female candidates belonging to Economically Weaker Section will be considered only under General/Unreserved category for the post of Station Officer.



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The male candidates who have applied earlier only through the prescribed online recruitment portal in response to the Notification dated 04.11.2022 need not apply again. Their eligibility with regard to age would be reckoned as per the cut-off date notified earlier.

1. QUALIFICATION FOR ELIGIBILITY:

A Bachelor's Degree from a recognized University/Institution.


2. AGE LIMIT:

Between 20 and 27* years of age as on 31.08.2023. Age limit is relaxable in respect of MBC, Ex-Servicemen applicants and In-service officials as detailed below:

* Relaxation of two years in the upper age limit prescribed for the post of Station Officer has been provided as a onetime measure as per G.O. Ms. No.50, dated 29.07.2022 issued by the Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms (Personnel Wing), Puducherry.

** Requirement of age for candidates belonging to various categories is given in Part-II of this Notification.



3. NATIVITY/RESIDENCE:

Those who are natives of Union Territory of Puducherry or residents by continuous residence in the U.T. of Puducherry for the last 5 years immediately preceding the date of notification only are eligible to apply for the post. The applicants, on selection, should furnish a fresh Nativity/Residence Certificate issued by an Officer of the Department of Revenue and Disaster Management, not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar, at the time of certificate verification.

4. COMMUNITY CERTIFICATE:

The selected applicants should submit a fresh Community Certificate for MBC obtained in the prescribed form issued by an Officer of the Department of Revenue and Disaster Management, not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar, at the time of certificate verification.

5. CERTIFICATE FOR EWS CANDIDATES:

The candidates selected under EWS category should submit Income & Asset Certificate obtained in the prescribed form issued by an Officer of the Department of Revenue and Disaster Management, not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar, at the time of certificate verification.

6. WIDOWS / DIVORCED WOMEN / WOMEN JUDICIALLY SEPARATED FROM THEIR HUSBANDS AND WHO ARE NOT REMARRIED:

The applicants who apply under the category of Widows/Divorced Women/Women Judicially Separated from their Husband and who are not re-married should necessarily submit a Certificate issued by an Officer of the Department of Revenue and Disaster Management not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar to the effect that they are not remarried at the time of certificate verification.

7. MODE OF RECRUITMENT:

The applicants will be notified in the website <https://recruitment.py.gov.in> with a call letter to appear for the following test. The date and venue of the test will be indicated therein.

(i) Physical Measurements / Physical Standards:

Only the candidates who possess the prescribed physical standards will be admitted for Physical Efficiency Test.

(ii) Physical Efficiency Test:

For male candidates

Stage-I	100 metres run	15.00 seconds
Stage-II	Long jump	3.80 metres
Stage-III	High jump	1.20 metres
Stage-IV	800 metres run	2 minutes and 50 seconds

For female candidates

Stage-III	High jump	0.90metres

Note: (a) All the above events are compulsory.


(b) Each stage is a qualifying stage by itself for the next stage i.e., only the candidates who qualify in Stage-I will be eligible for Stage-II and so on.

(c) Ex-Servicemen will not be required to pass the Physical Efficiency Test. They will be eligible to appear for the written test if they possess the minimum physical measurements/standards and pass the medical examination.

(iii) Written Test:

(a) Only the candidates who possess the prescribed Physical Standards and qualify in the Physical Efficiency Test will undergo Written Test. The questions for the written test will be of objective type for 100 marks of two hours duration having 100 questions carrying one mark each, consisting of:

Negative mark of 0.25 will be awarded for every wrong answer and multiple answers will be treated as a wrong answer. Candidates are, therefore, advised to keep this aspect in mind while answering the questions.

(b) The question paper for the Written Test will be bilingual (except General English) i.e., in English and in any one of the regional languages, namely Tamil or Telugu or Malayalam. Therefore, the candidates should indicate the choice of the language in which they prefer to write the examination, in the online application.

(c) Answering would be in the form of shading the correct answer by using BLACK BALL POINT PEN only and the applicants are permitted to take the carbon copy of their answer sheet along with their question booklet.

(d) The answer key will be published in the recruitment website <https://recruitment.py.gov.in> and also in the official website of the Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms viz., <https://dpar.py.gov.in> after completion of examination process.

(e) Minimum qualifying marks prescribed for the Written Test:


A list of candidates will be provisionally shortlisted from the merit list based on the marks obtained by the applicants in the Written Test, subject to reservation as per the rules in force. Minimum qualifying marks to be secured by the various categories of candidates are as follows:-

UR	: 30%
MBC/EWS#	: 25%
XSM	: 20%

Note:

The validity of operation of wait list, if drawn, will be two years from the date of declaration of the result / publication of select list. The wait list will be operated in the event of occurrence of a vacancy caused in the Select List due to rejection of candidature for non-production of required certificates, non-appearance of candidate for certificate verification, non-joining of candidate within the stipulated time allowed for joining the post or when a candidate joins but resigns or dies within a period of one year from the date of joining, etc.

As there is no reservation for EWS category for female candidates in this recruitment, female candidates belonging to Economically Weaker Sections should secure the minimum qualifying marks prescribed for UR.



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(iv) Medical Examination:

The candidates who pass the Written Test shall undergo medical examination as detailed below. They must be certified to possess the medical standards specified below:-

(a) Eye Sight:-

- (i) Distant vision : (A) Normal – Both eyes should be 6/6
(OR)
(B) Better eye with correction 6/6
(C) Worse eye vision 6/12 (without correction)
(OR)
(D) Both eyes should be 6/9

- (ii) Near vision : (E) Normal – Both eyes should be JI
(OR)
(F) Better eye with correction JI and worse eye without correction JII

- (iii) Colour Blindness : (G) Free from colour blindness

(b) Hearing : Free from any disability.

(c) Defects or deformity : Free from any defect or deformity of limbs.

(d) Disease : Free from hernia, piles, respiratory disease, diabetes or any other disease, which will adversely affect the work of Station Officer.


(e) Other : Should not be flat-footed or suffering from knocked knees and bowed legs and should not be overweight.

8. DATE AND VENUE OF EXAMINATION:

The Physical Standards Test, Physical Efficiency Test and Written Test will be held in Puducherry only. The exact date, time and venue of the examination will be intimated in due course in the recruitment website and also in leading newspapers.

9. HOW TO APPLY AND LAST DATE FOR APPLICATION:

Applicants fulfilling the eligibility criteria as mentioned above may apply online only through the official website <https://recruitment.py.gov.in> from 04.08.2023 (10:00 a.m.) to 31.08.2023 (05:45 p.m.).



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Note:

As there is no reservation for EWS category for female candidates in this recruitment, female candidates belonging to Economically Weaker Section will be considered only under General/Unreserved category for the post of Station Officer.

10. PROCEDURE FOR IN-SERVICE APPLICANTS:

Only the candidates working as "Fireman" and "Leading Fireman" in the Fire Service Department, Government of Puducherry will be considered as feeder/allied cadre for the post of Station Officer and allowed to appear as In-service candidates by availing the permissible age relaxation mentioned in the statement under "2. AGE LIMIT" of this notification and subject to fulfillment of educational qualification prescribed for the post of Station Officer at "1. QUALIFICATION FOR ELIGIBILITY".

Applicants who are working in this Department and applying as In-service applicant with age concession also satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions, should submit a copy of the online generated application through proper channel, within the due date i.e., on or before 05:45 p.m. on 31.08.2023 to "The Under Secretary to Government (Home)-cum-Head of Office (Fire Service), Fire Service Department, Puducherry". The applications of In-service candidates which are not duly forwarded through proper channel within the due date and time of 05:45 p.m. on 31.08.2023 (last date for applying) will be summarily rejected. Advance copy of the application for In-service candidates will not be entertained.

11. TRAINING AND PROBATION:


On selection, the candidates will be placed on probation for a period of two years and shall have to undergo basic training course (Sub-Officers' Course conducted by the National Fire Service College, Nagpur) for the prescribed period and pass the prescribed examination.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

PART-I

Applicants should read the following instructions scrupulously before applying:

1. Mode of applying for recruitment to the post of Station Officer is only through online.
2. Avoid registering multiple online applications and register only a single application. All multiple online applications will be cancelled.

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3. The applicants have to register with their Mobile Number in the online portal "https://recruitment.py.gov.in" for applying through online. They will receive Username and Password through SMS in the mobile number provided during registration. Thereafter, the applicants have to login into the online portal using the username and password for applying to the post of Station Officer.

4. **Photograph & Signature uploading:** Applicants shall upload their photograph and signature using either Option 1 or Option 2 provided in the recruitment portal as given below:-

Option 1 (Scanning Photograph and Signature as a single image):

Applicants are instructed to scan their recent passport size colour photograph & signature on an A4 sheet with 200 DPI resolution, dimensions should be minimum of 600x600 pixel and the file size should be less than 150KB (as shown in the guidelines video for uploading and cropping the photograph and signature during online application).

Option 2 (Scanning Photograph and Signature as separate images):

Applicants are instructed to scan their recent passport size colour photograph in JPEG format with 238x306 pixel dimensions and the file size should be less than 50KB. Scan the signature as JPEG file with 350x150 pixel dimensions and file size should be less than 30KB.


5. The applicants are also advised to change the default password received in their mobile at first login. It is the applicant's responsibility to take ownership of the password and should not be disclosed to anyone. Otherwise, the liabilities which arise upon will be the applicant's risk.

6. The applicants will be allowed to view, print and check the status of their application and download the Hall Ticket by logging in into the online portal using the username and password they received in their mobile number. Hence, they are advised to keep the username and password safe for future reference until the recruitment process is over.


7. The applicant, after applying, can also make corrections in their online application, if any error occurred while entering their data. They are allowed to avail this facility till 05:45 p.m. on **31.08.2023**.

8. The information/data furnished by the applicants in the online application are final and cannot be altered later after the last date for applying i.e., **31.08.2023**.

9. The applicants are advised to have a copy of the online generated application for their reference.



10. Applicants, except 'In-service' candidates, need not send the hardcopy of their online application or any other supporting documents to this Department.
11. Applicants who are applying as In-service candidates should submit a copy of their online application to the undersigned through proper channel within the due date and time of 31.08.2023 (05:45 p.m.).
12. Candidates applying under In-service category are instructed to make their online application well in advance so as to submit the hardcopy of the online generated application to the undersigned within the last date.
13. Certificates are required to be produced by the provisionally shortlisted candidates after the notification of results of this recruitment, at the time of Certificate Verification.
14. This Department will not undertake detailed scrutiny of applications for the eligibility and other aspects at the time of written examination and therefore, candidature will be accepted only provisionally. Candidates must go through the requirements of educational qualification, age, physical and medical standards etc. and satisfy themselves that they are eligible for the post. Copies of supporting documents will be sought at the time of Certificate Verification. When scrutiny is undertaken, if any claim made in the application is not found substantiated, the candidature will be cancelled and the Departmental Recruitment Committee's decision shall be final.
15. Candidates seeking reservation benefits available for MBC/EWS/XSM must ensure that they are entitled to such reservation as per the eligibility prescribed in the notification. They should also be in possession of the certificates in prescribed forms in support of their claim.
16. All the communications with regard to this recruitment will be published in the website <https://recruitment.py.gov.in>. Applicants are advised to visit the above website regularly and follow news and dailies for information. They are advised to keep the mobile number given in their online application active for sending SMS connected with this recruitment.
17. After scrutiny, the status of the application will be indicated in the website <https://recruitment.py.gov.in>. Applicants are advised to check the official website to know their application status.
18. The decision of the Government as to the eligibility or otherwise of the applicant for admission to the Physical Standard Test/Physical Efficiency Test/Written Test shall be final.

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19. No correspondence will be entertained with regard to the recruitment process. Candidates are advised to verify the status of their application, hall ticket, etc. through online only.

20. A separate press note will be issued in leading regional news dailies regarding the issue of hall tickets through online. The eligible applicants can download their Hall Tickets from the website <https://recruitment.py.gov.in> by using the "Username and Password". Hall ticket for Written Test will be available online, only to the candidates who are qualified in the Physical Standards Test and Physical Efficiency Test.

21. **Change of address and mobile number, if any, after submission of application should invariably be intimated to the Department by Registered Post with Acknowledgement Due.** Otherwise, the Department will not be responsible for any delay/non-delivery of letters/SMS messages.


22. No request for change of Examination Centre will be entertained.

23. The Physical Standards Test, Physical Efficiency Test, Written Test and Medical Examination will be held in Puducherry only. Candidates will have to appear for the Physical Standards Test, Physical Efficiency Test and Written Test at their own expenses. T.A to SC/ST candidates from outlying regions (Karaikal/Mahe/Yanam) for attending the Physical Standard Test/Physical Efficiency Test and Written Test for Direct Recruitment to the post of Station Officer will be paid as Second Class rail fare excluding reservation/sleeper charges or bus fare, to and fro, subject to production of original tickets.

24. Admission to Physical Standards Test/Physical Efficiency Test/Written Test is only provisional. Success in the written test confers no right to appointment. The appointment is subject to verification of educational qualification/nativity/residence/community and any other special category claimed by the individual including medical fitness subject to verification of character and antecedents.


PART-III

Government of India, Ministry of Personnel, P.G. and Pensions, Dept. of Pers. & Training, New Delhi, O.M. No.36034/21/87-Estt.(SCT), dated 7th November, 1989

Sub.: Second time benefit to ex-servicemen for reservation in Groups 'C' and 'D' posts/services not allowed.

In this Department's O.M. No.36034/27/84-Estt.(SCT) dated 02.05.1985, it was decided that the second time benefit of ex-servicemen will not be admissible to those ex-servicemen who have already availed of the benefit of Ex-servicemen on their first re-employment in civilian posts. On the request made by Directorate General of Resettlement, Ministry of Defence, that the decision contained in the above OM dated 02.05.1985, should not be made applicable to those Ex-servicemen who have been re-employed or are re-employed by the Private Companies/Autonomous Bodies/Public Sector Undertakings and Government Offices on casual/contract/ temporary *ad hoc* basis and who can be removed from such service at any time by the Employer concerned, the matter has been reconsidered by this Department and it has been decided that the provisions contained in this Department's OM No. 36034/27/84-Estt.(SCT) dated 02.05.1985, shall not apply to those ex-servicemen who have been re-employed or are re-employed by Private Companies/Autonomous Bodies/Public Sector Undertakings/ Government Offices on casual/contract/Temporary *ad hoc* basis and who can be removed from such service at any time by their employer concerned.

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Government of India, Ministry of Personnel, P.G. and Pensions, Dept. of Pers. & Training, New Delhi, O.M. No.36034/6/90-Estt.(SCT), dated 2nd April, 1992

Sub.: Benefit of age concession to Ex-servicemen who have already joined Govt. service for applying for employment in a higher grade/cadre under the Central Govt. Group C & D.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's O.M. No.36034/27/84-Estt.(SCT), dated 02.05.1985 wherein it has been clarified that on an ex-servicemen joining civil appointment he is deemed to be a civil employee and will accordingly be entitled to only such of the benefits like relaxation of age etc. as admissible to civil employees, in accordance with the existing instructions in this regard. Representations have been received requesting the Govt. to reconsider the above decision. The matter has also been raised by the Staff Side of the National Council (JCM) suggesting that at least the benefit of age relaxation should be allowed to those ex-servicemen candidates who have joined a civil post under the Govt. of India and who wish to improve their career prospects.

2. The matter has been examined in this Department in consultation with Ministry of Defence and the Department of Public Enterprises and it has now been decided that such of those ex-servicemen candidates who have already secured employment under the Central Govt. in Groups C & D will be permitted the benefit of age relaxation as prescribed for ex-servicemen for securing another employment in a higher grade or cadre in Group C/D under the Central Govt. However, such candidates will not be eligible for the benefit of reservation for ex-servicemen in Central Govt. jobs.

The above decision is in modification of Provision of this Department's O.M. No.36034/27/84-Estt.(SCT), dated 02.05.1985.

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Government of India, Ministry of Personnel, P.G. and Pensions, Dept. of Pers. & Training, New Delhi, O.M. No.36034/1/2014-Estt.(Res.), dated 14th August, 2014

Sub.: Benefit of reservation to Ex-servicemen, who applies for various examinations/vacancies before joining civil posts/services in the Government job on civil side.

In terms of this Department's Notification No.39016/10/79-Estt(C) dated 15th December, 1979 as amended from time to time and which was last amended vide Notification No.36034/1/2006-Estt (Res) dated 4th October, 2012, the benefit of reservation to ex-servicemen is available at ten per cent of the vacancies in Group C posts and twenty percent of the vacancies in Group D posts in all the Central Civil Services and posts. Benefit of reservation is also extended at ten per cent of the vacancies in the posts up to of the level of Assistant Commandant in all para-military forces to be filled by direct recruitment.

2. Vide this Department's O.M. No. 36034/27/84-Estt.(SCT) dated 02.05.1985, it was decided that once an ex-serviceman has joined the Government job on civil side after availing of the benefits given to him as an ex-serviceman for his re-employment, his



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ex-serviceman status for the purpose of re-employment in Government would cease. It was also decided that on his joining the civil employment, he would be deemed to be a civil employee and would accordingly be entitled to only such of the benefits like relaxation of age etc. as admissible to civil employees in the normal course. Vide this Department's O.M. No. 36034/21/87-Estt.(SCT) dated 07.11.1989, it was clarified that the instructions of 02.05.1985 shall not apply to those ex-servicemen who have been re-employed or are re-employed by private companies/autonomous bodies/public sector undertakings/government offices on casual/contract/temporary *ad-hoc* basis and who can be removed from such service at any time by their employer concerned.

3. An ex-serviceman at the time of his release or discharge from the armed forces normally applies for more than one vacancy, but in case he/she joins any civil employment due to early declaration of results/selection, he/she is not entitled for the benefit of reservation for ex-servicemen for subsequent employment. It has been brought to the notice of this Department that the aforesaid instructions are affecting the chances of ex-servicemen in the case of direct recruitment for subsequent suitable employment.

4. The matter has, therefore, been considered in consultation with Department of Ex-servicemen, Ministry of Defence. It has now been decided that if an ex-serviceman applies for various vacancies before joining any civil employment, he/she can avail of the benefit of reservation as ex-serviceman for any subsequent employment. However, to avail of this benefit, an ex-serviceman as soon as he/she joins any civil employment, should give self-declaration/undertaking to the concerned employer about the date-wise details of application for various vacancies for which he/she had applied for before joining the initial civil employment. Further, this benefit would be available only in respect of vacancies which are filled on direct recruitment and wherever reservation is applicable to the ex-servicemen.

5. The above Orders shall take effect from the date of issue of this Office Memorandum.



They must be certified to possess the medical standards specified below:- (a) Eye Sight:- (i) Distant vision: (A) Normal - Both eyes should be 6/6 (OR) (B) Better eye with correction 6/6 (C) Worse eye vision 6/12 (without correction) (OR) (D) Both eyes should be 6/9 (ii) Near vision: (E) Normal - Both eyes should be JI (OR) (F) Better eye with correction JI and worse eye without correction JII (iii) Colour Blindness: (G) Free from colour blindness

2. All other things remain unaltered.
